~The Ceremony of the Washing of Feet~

Dear beloved in Christ,

On the night before His death, our Saviour set an example for His disciples by washing the Apostle's feet, in an act of humble service. None stand more in need of this reminder of the nature of Christian service, than those whom the Lord has called to the ordained ministry.

Therefore I invite those who have been appointed to represent this congregation to come forward, that I may recall whose servant I am, by following the example of our Master. But come, remembering that all who share in the royal priesthood of Christ in His Church, must then extend to others the same spirit of humility and service which He commanded His ministers to extend to His flock. If you know these things, blessed are ye that *do* them.

Appointed members of the congregation come forward, remove their shoes and stockings, and be seated.
